**Capture the Flag Event:** The Capture the Flag event on Wednesday, 9/11, will be from 1:00 – 5:00 pm and is open to spectators.

**Parking:** InfoSec has secured parking spaces in the Music City Center parking garages. Use entrances P-1, P-2, and P-3. Complimentary Parking is available on a first come, first served basis. **PAPER PARKING TICKETS WILL BE UTILIZED ON 9/11.** Take a ticket when you enter the garage; pick up a parking voucher at the InfoSec registration desk.
