What is the ISSA?

Formed in 1982, The Information Systems Security Association (ISSA) is an international organization with 140 plus chapters located throughout the world. ISSA provides educational forums, publications, and peer interaction opportunities. That enhances the knowledge, skills and professional growth of its members – information security professionals.

The primary goal of the ISSA is to promote management practices that will ensure availability, integrity and confidentiality of organized resources.

ISSA Middle Tennessee Chapter

The Middle Tennessee Chapter of the ISSA is composed of security professionals in a variety of important, decision- making capacities at leading organizations around the Middle Tennessee Region and surrounding areas. The members of the Chapter could be categorized this way; a mix of executives, management and experienced professionals, with most having more than 6 years of experience in security systems. Over 90% of our membership influences or support purchasing decisions, while 30% or more make purchasing decisions.

The Middle Tennessee Chapter is an active chapter with approximately 200 members and numerous chapter meetings, functions, and activities during the year. Of special note is our annual Security Conference, InfoSec Nashville, held at the Music City Center, which draws more than 600 participants from across the country annually.

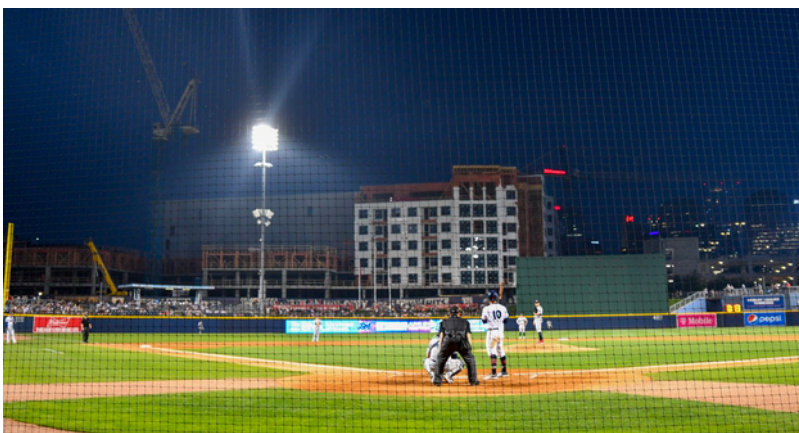
